1. Outline

Kyushu University is seeking an experienced individual with expertise in teaching and research for appointment as one tenured Associate Professor in the International Development Section, Institute of Tropical Agriculture.

Institute of Tropical Agriculture, Kyushu University is one of the joint-use facilities of the university, and involves in conducting research, education and international cooperation on tropical agriculture with three sections, Tropical Crops and Environment Section, Land-Water Resources and Environment Conservation Section and International Development Section. The International Development Section conducts advanced education and research on the conservation of the water environment, which is the foundation of agricultural production and rural life in tropical regions, and on the development and use of ICT (Information and Communication Technology) in agriculture. In addition, this section is strengthening the information dissemination function by building a network with overseas universities and research institutes and also actively engaged in acquiring international development project. The associate professor of the Section participates in the education of master's and doctoral course programs as Graduate School of Bioresource and Bioenvironmental Sciences, and lectures the undergraduate students in School of Agriculture.
